

# TOWN OF MOUNTAIN ANNUAL MEETING    MAY 12, 2020 MINUTES

The Annual Meeting was called to order by Chairman Maletzke at 7:00 p.m. pursuant to WI SS 60.11(1) with 8 voting elector, 4 town board members, 1 property owner attendees, and 4 guests. Registration is by poll list verification pursuant to WI SS 60.11(7). The Pledge of Allegiance is said.

Presentation from Mary Beth Ascher on the Suring Public Library Joint Library Agreement to be discussed at the Town Board meeting; with the Town of Mountain and Town of Brazeau to be added for 2020-2021.

General concerns addressed included:

- Michael Hill requested that the Town Board consider opening up County W from Doran Road to Old 32 for ATV access, as this would be safer route because currently you have to cross State Highway 32/64 twice to get to gas station in town; with speed limit 35 MPH or less he stated Town could regulate this.
  
- Kelly Krieger questioned how some towns can be regulating bars/restaurants opening for business and not others
  
- Patricia Hull inquired if there were parking restrictions on Town roads; provided example of trucks blocking 3/4 of road for tree trimming/removal operations
