Motion to approve the preamble and Resolution to Borrow Funds and Levy Tax for Financing addition to Town Office/Shop received from Board of Commissioners of Public Lands with application for state trust fund loan by O'Barski. Seconded by Carey-Mielke. Roll call vote – O'Barski – Aye; Carey-Mielke – Aye; Maletzke – Aye. Motion carried.

**Cemetery Seasonal Help** – recommendation by Cemetery Committee to hire high school student for seasonal summer help at cemetery, Sup. O'Barski had interviewed a student, application available for review. Motion to hire Michael Bailey for seasonal summer help at a rate of \$10.00 per hour to operate a push mower, weed eater and as needed by O'Barski. Seconded by Carey-Mielke. Motion carried.
